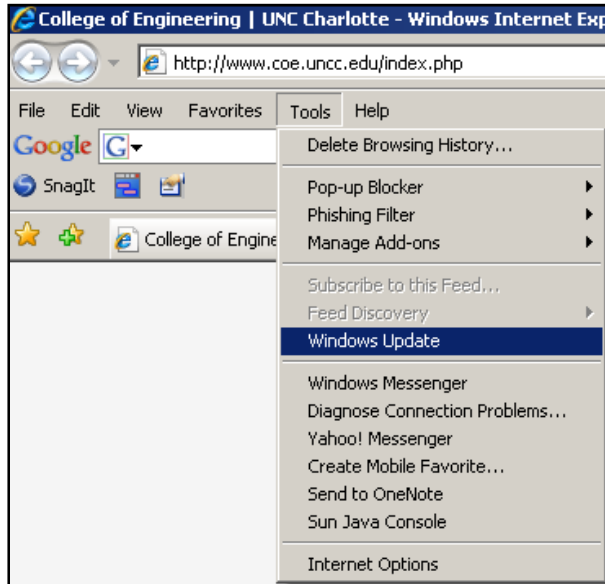


How to install Windows update patches on your computer

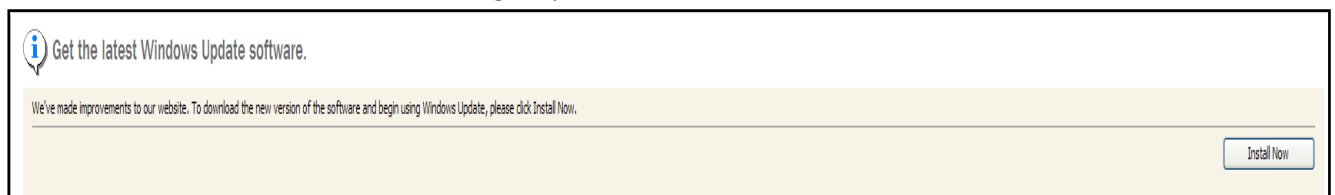
1. Open Windows Internet Explorer.
2. Go to “Tools” then “Windows Update”



3. It may take a minute while it checks if your computer has the latest version of Windows updating software for use with the website. If the dialogue box below appears, click on “Install”



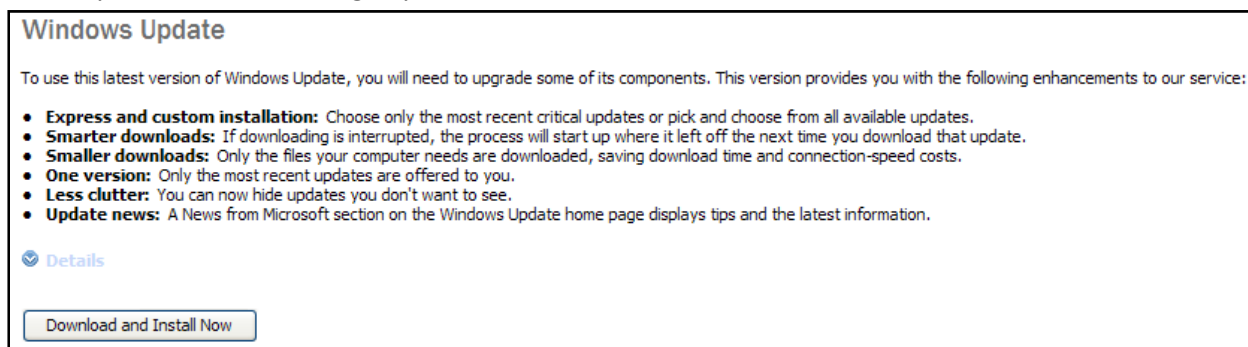
4. You should then see the following on your screen. Click on “Install Now”



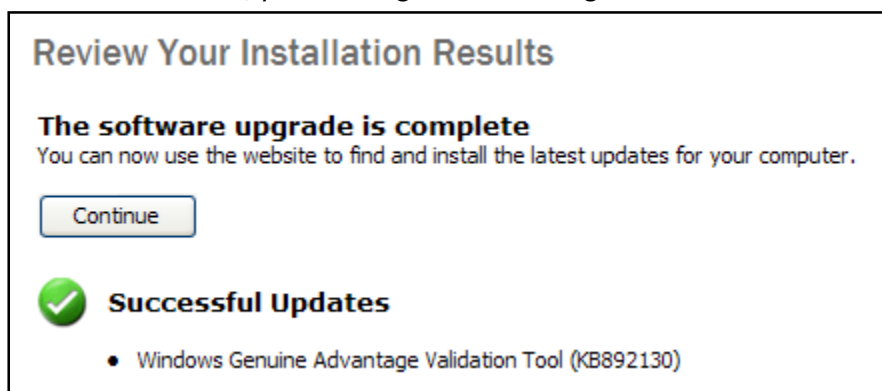
5. You should see “Windows Update is downloading and installing the updated software”
6. You should see the following options: Click on “Express”




7. This will check for any needed updates. It will take a few minutes to complete.
8. You may receive the following, if you do, click on “Download and Install Now”



9. After a minute or so, you should get the following screen: click on “Continue”



10. You should then see the results of the scan and any needed updates. You are practically looking for a file called (KB958644). If you do not see this file, you may already have the patch installed.

11. Click on "Install Updates". This may take some time, depending on how many other updates are needed in your system. Afterwards, it will ask you to restart your machine, please do so.
